How To Make A Chatterbox

<p>1. Fold a sheet of A4 (letter size) paper along the dotted line.</p>		<p>6. Take a corner and fold it into the centre. Repeat with other corners.</p>	
<p>2. Cut off excess paper.</p>		<p>7. Repeat with other corners.</p>	
<p>3. Open out and fold corner to corner.</p>		<p>8. Fold in half.</p>	
<p>4. Take one corner and fold it into the centre. Repeat with other 3 corners.</p>		<p>9. Push your thumb and index fingers into the outer flaps until it turns into a chatterbox shape.</p>	
<p>5. Turn the piece of paper over.</p>		<p>10. Looking at the chatterbox from above you can see that it can be opened in two directions - forwards and backwards, or right to left.</p>
